## GENERAL INFORMATION

- Everyone who visits QAG or GOMA now needs a timed ticket for entry, as part of our Queensland Health Department approved COVID- safe plan. To book your free ticket, visit our website ([qagoma.qld.gov.au/visit/plan-your-visit](http://qagoma.qld.gov.au/visit/plan-your-visit))
- If you wish to, you are allowed to wear a face mask during your visit.
- COVID Safe entry guidelines are at each entry point. Hand sanitiser is available throughout each gallery.
- Certain items are not allowed in the Gallery. This is for safety of the artworks on display. You cannot bring in food and drinks, large items such as backpacks and sticky items such as putty.
- You can store items that you are not allowed to take into the Gallery in the cloakroom
- You can take quiet sensory tools/stimming toys into the Gallery
- Please do not touch the artworks. This can cause damage.
- Due to room capacity in the Children's Art Centre exhibition, 'Now is the Time' at GOMA, we ask that prams are parked in a designated area nearby
- The air-conditioning vents at GOMA are in the floor throughout the building. At QAG they are in or near the ceilings.
- The temperature in both QAG and GOMA is maintained at 21.5 degrees. This is the best temperature to conserve the artworks. You may like to bring an extra layer of clothing to keep warm.
- Some bathrooms have sensor lights which activate when you enter.

**Note:** School groups visiting on the day will be notified in advance about this event. The most popular time for school group visits is between 10.00am and 1.30pm. On most days QAG and GOMA are generally less crowded after 3.00pm.









## CURRENT EXHIBITIONS

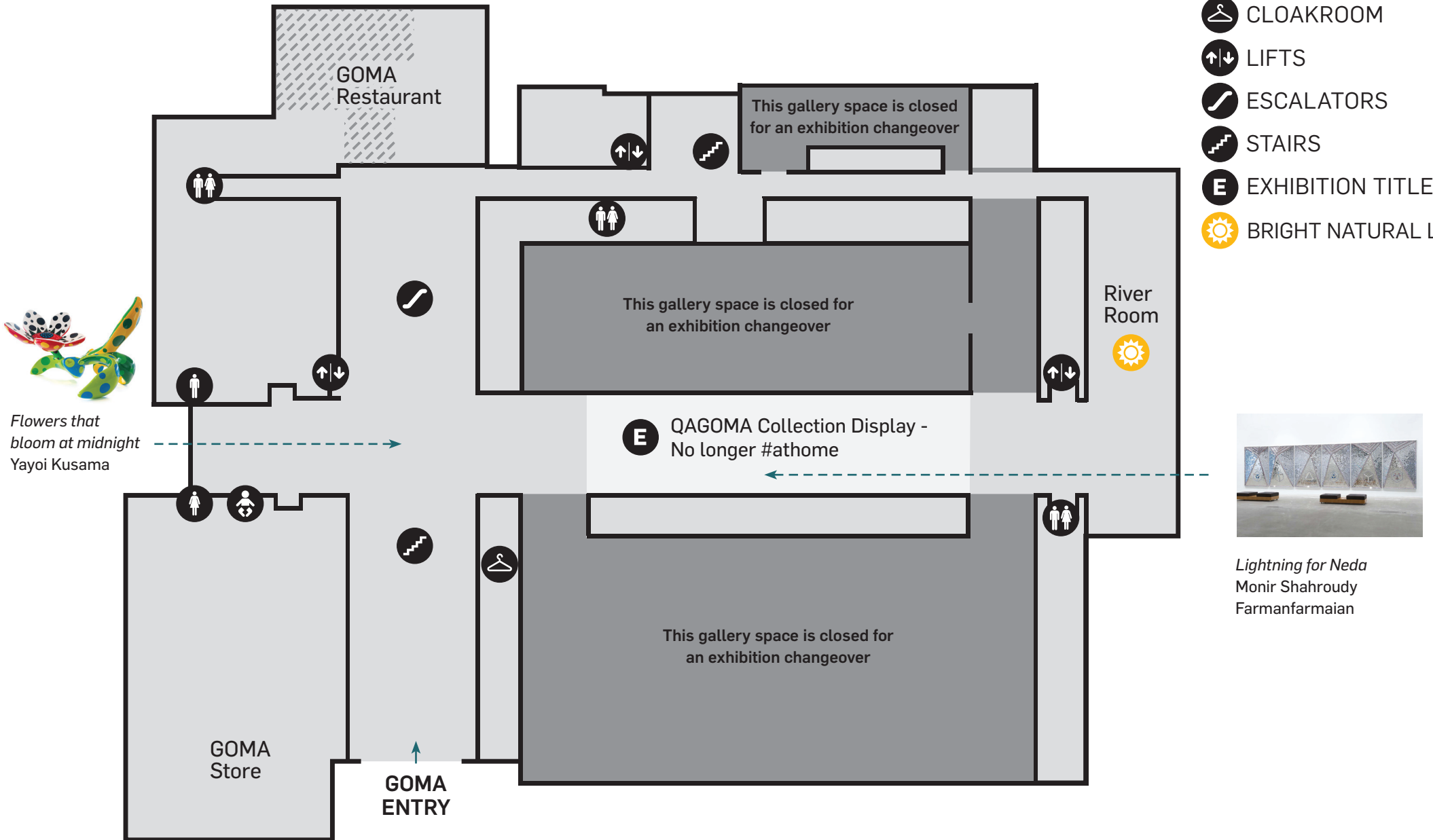
- Current exhibitions are marked on the accompanying floorplans

- All exhibitions currently on display at QAG and GOMA are free, however due to the impact of COVID-19, timed entry tickets are now required to enter either building
- You can take photos of artworks, but you can't use a flash
- 'Now is the Time' at GOMA is an interactive exhibition for children and families, presented by the Children's Art Centre. Capacity is limited to 30 people at any one time and our friendly staff are onsite to assist.
- At QAG you will see a large-scale installation by Ai Wei Wei titled '*Boomerang*' hanging from the ceiling above the Watermall. It is safely secured with strong chains.

## SENSORY EXPERIENCES







- Signs in the gallery will point out the location of high sensory areas
- Some areas within the galleries are brightly lit while others have low lighting
- You can wear a cap and/or sunglasses if you are sensitive to bright light
- There are a number of artworks with sound. The volume will be lowered or switched off where possible.
- You can bring noise cancelling headphones if you are sensitive to sound
- There are quiet zones with comfortable seating in each building and these are indicated on the floor plans. At GOMA, the quiet zone is the River Lounge on level 3. This space faces the river and is filled with natural light. At QAG, the quiet zone is the Member's Lounge on level 2.

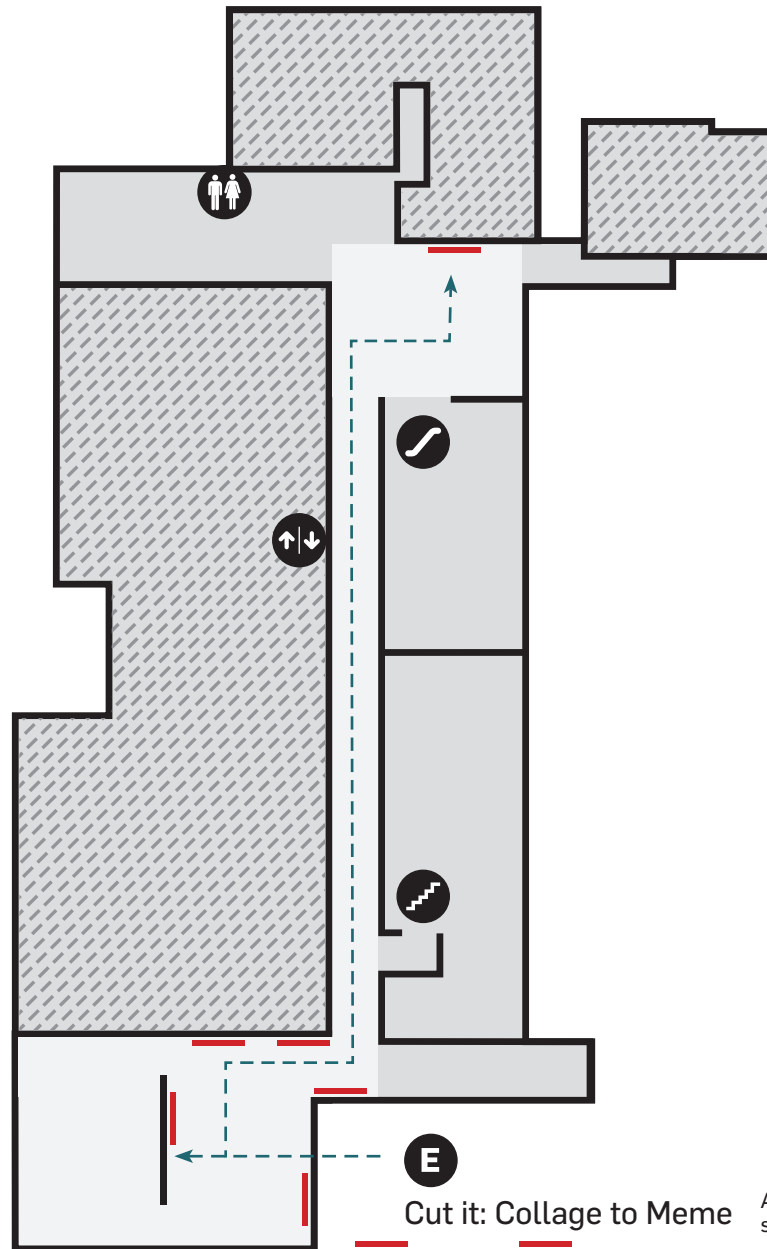

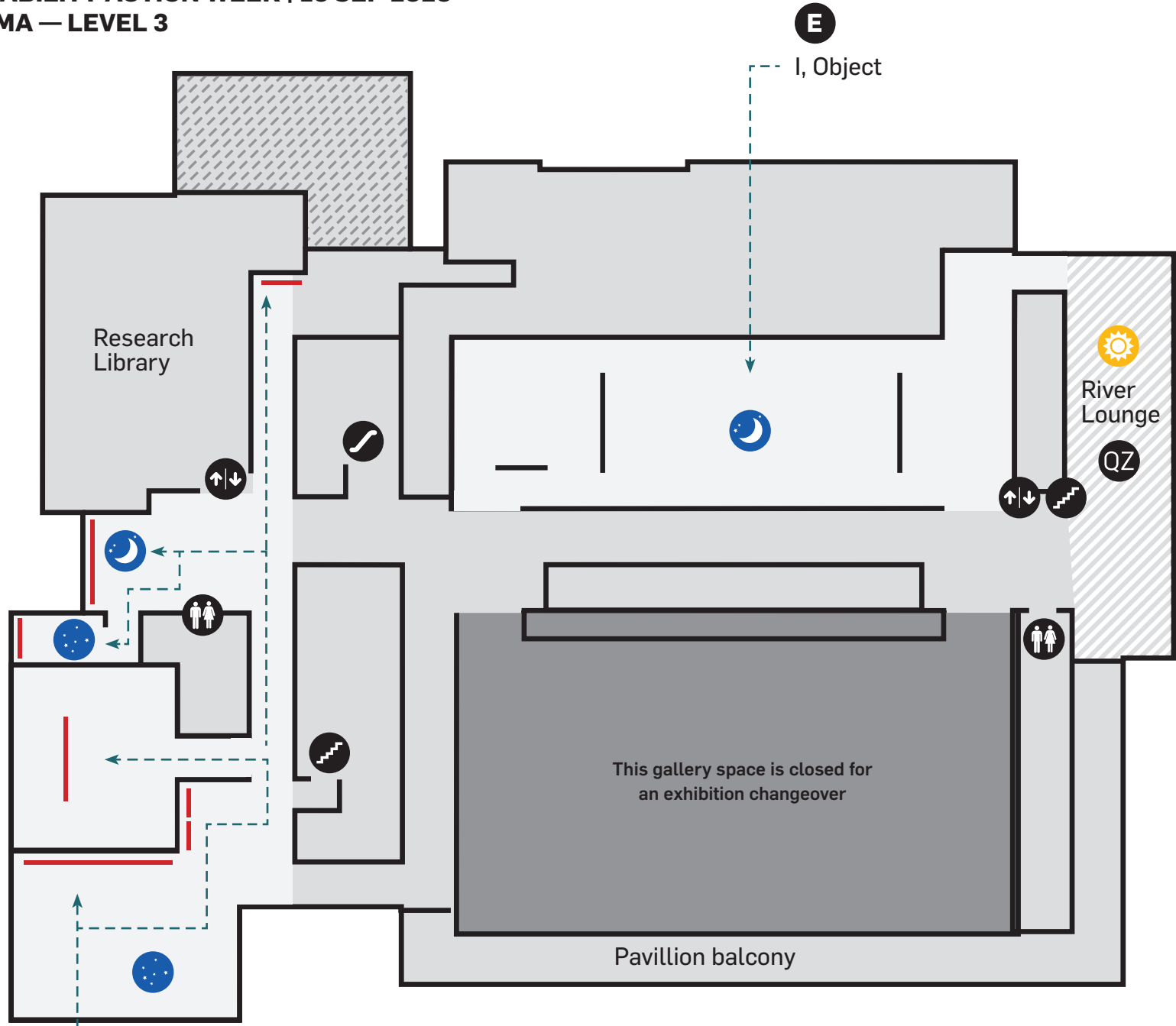

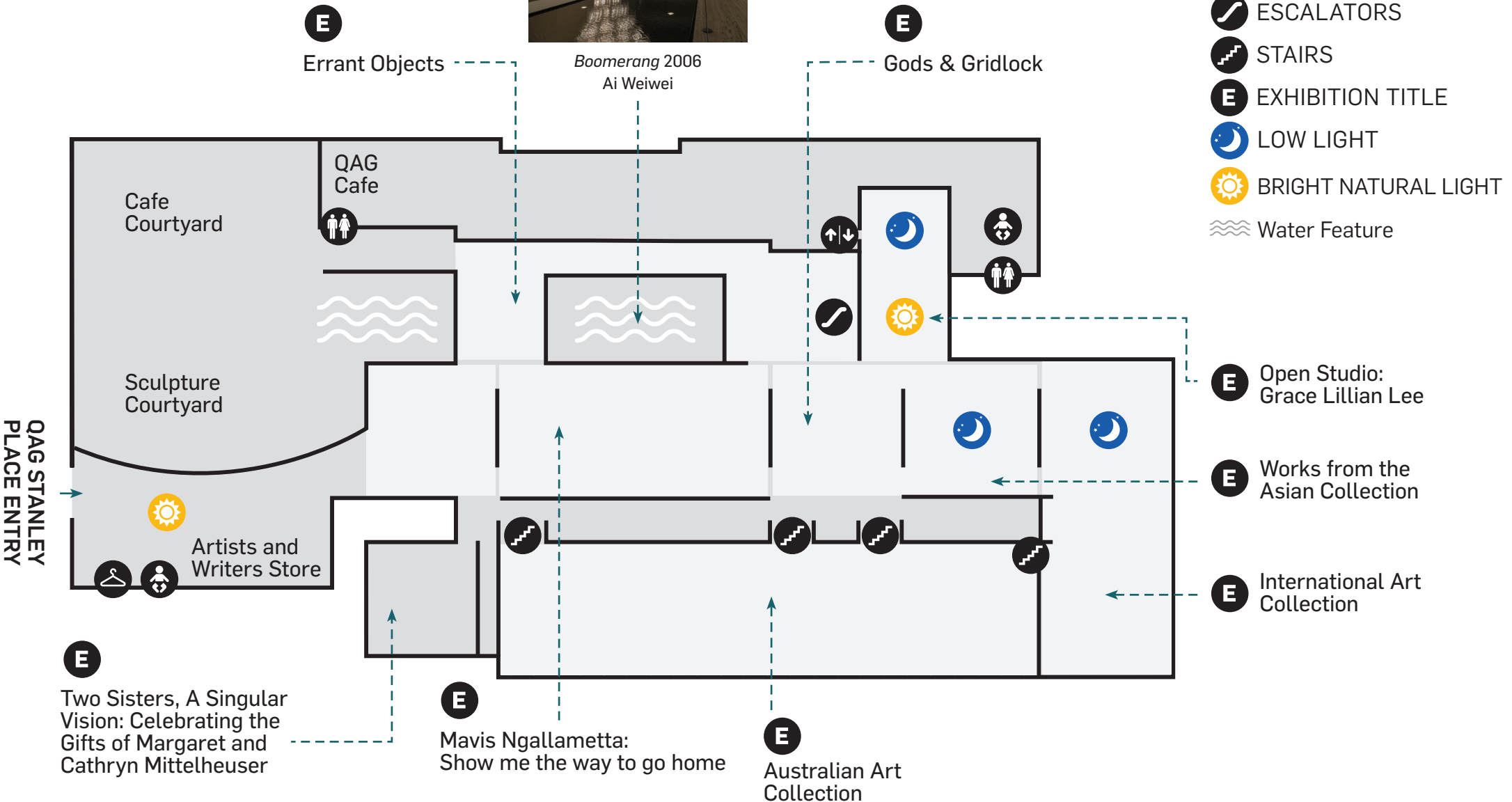
